CONT.**

MATHEMATICS 4 UNITS

Courses should include Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and a fourth, higher level mathematics class.

SCIENCE 4 UNITS

Courses should include Biology I and Chemistry, and any two Carnegie units of comparable rigor and content (e.g. Physics, Physical Science, Human Anatomy & Physiology, Biology II, Chemistry II, Physics II, AP Physics B, AP Physics C, Botany, or Microbiology.)

SOCIAL STUDIES 4 UNITS

Courses should include U.S. History, World History, Introduction to World Geography, U.S. Government, Economics, and Mississippi Studies (Credit earned for a State/Local Government course in any other state may stand in lieu of Mississippi Studies.)

ARTS 1 UNIT

Includes any one unit of visual and performing arts course(s) meeting the requirements for high school graduation.

ADV. ELECTIVES 2 UNITS

Includes any two units of Foreign Language (I and II), Advanced World Geography and a Foreign Language (I), or any combination of English, mathematics, or lab-based science courses of comparable rigor and content to those required above.

COMPUTER APPLICATIONS ½ UNIT

Course should emphasize the computer as a productivity tool. Instruction should include the use of application packages, such as word processing and spreadsheets. It should also include basic computer terminology and hardware operation.

PRE-HIGH SCHOOL UNITS

Courses taken prior to high school will be accepted for admission, provided the course earns Carnegie credit and the content is the same as the high school course.
